SECTION 4. FIRST-AID MEASURES

First-aid Measures

Inhalation

Disposal:

If breathing is difficult, move person into fresh air. Keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Immediately call a Poison Centre or doctor.

Skin Contact
